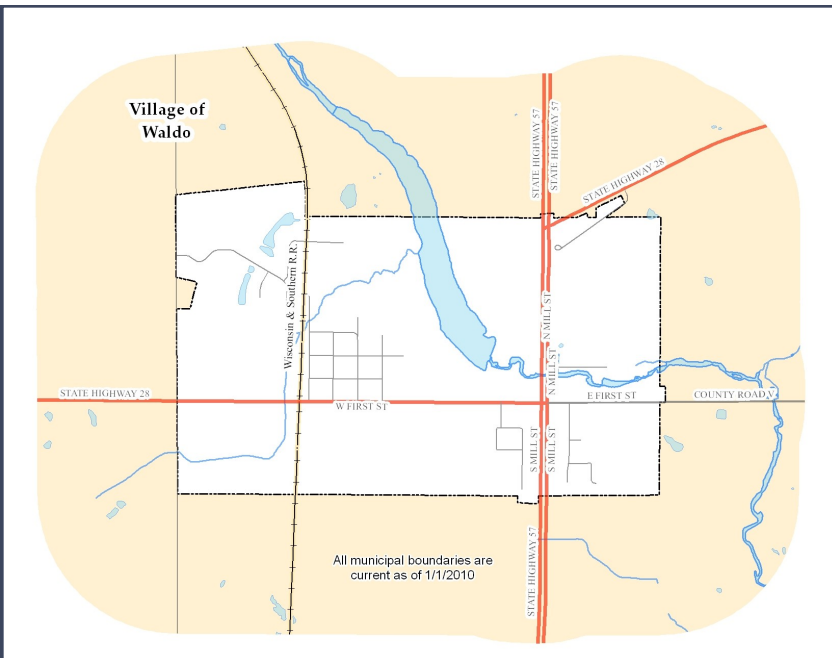




Village of Waldo, WI

LABOR FORCE

In 2000, Waldo had 256 residents, or 71.3% of the population, in the labor force. In March of 2010, Sheboygan County has a total of 63,379 people in the labor force and an unemployment rate of 10.0%.

TRANSPORTATION

The Village of Waldo is located along State Highways 28 & 57 and County Road V. This location provides easy access to surrounding communities and the City of Milwaukee. No rail service is not available in Waldo. Sheboygan County Memorial Airport is 12 miles away.

HOUSING

Using 2000 Census data, the median housing value in the Village was \$100,900 and is less than the median housing value of the entire County.

BUSINESS PARKS
