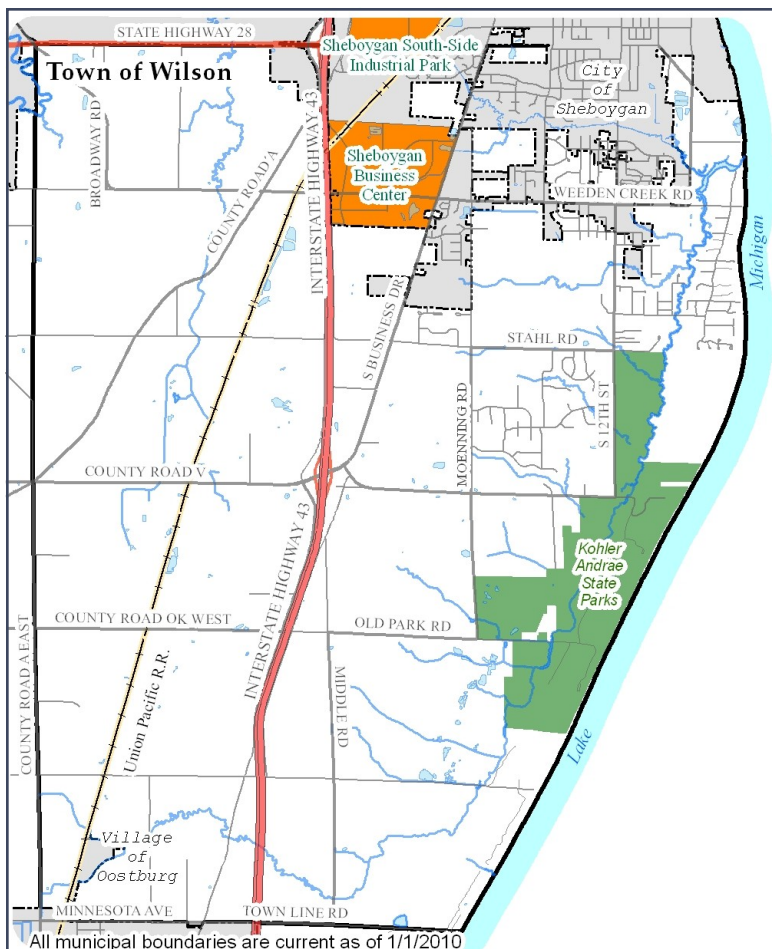




Town of Wilson, WI ECONOMIC PROFILE

The Town of Wilson is located on the shore of Lake Michigan, immediately south of the City of Sheboygan. The Town of Wilson offers a beautiful rural residential area with nearby city conveniences. LABOR FORCE

UTILITIES

WATER & SEWER

The Town of Wilson does not have a public water system; residents/businesses own and maintain their own wells. Most of the Town has individual private on-site wastewater treatment systems for sewer, but heavily populated areas within the Town are served the Town of Wilson Sanitary Districts with treatment of the sewage at the City of Sheboygan's Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant.

ELECTRICITY

Provided by Alliant Energy or We Energies.

NATURAL GAS

Provided by Wisconsin Public Service (WPS).

TELECOMMUNICATIONS

Landline phone service is provided by AT&T. Broadband internet is offered by Charter communications and AT&T.

TRANSPORTATION

The Town is intersected by Interstate 43 and State Highway 28. Rail service is provided by the Union Pacific Railroad (UP). Sheboygan County Memorial Airport (SMB) is 11 miles away.

HOUSING

Using 2000 Census data, the median housing value in the Town was \$134,600 and is higher than the median housing value of the entire County.

BUSINESS PARKS

Currently there are no business parks in the Town of Wilson. The Town of Wilson's business corridor is located along Interstate 43. The areas along County Roads OK, A, and V are areas where the Town will encourage future commercial and industrial growth.
