




Town of Greenbush, WI ECONOMIC PROFILE

The Town of Greenbush is located in western Sheboygan County along the Fond du Lac County border. The Town of Greenbush is a predominately agricultural and open/green land scattered with single-family residences. The Town borders the Villages of Glenbeulah and St. Cloud. The Town is home to the Wade House, a state historical site, as well as the Kettle Moraine State Forest-Northern Unit and the Broughton Sheboygan Marsh Park. The Town values its natural resources and rural, country atmosphere.



POPULATION

Greenbush's population reflects the presence of the Kettle Moraine Correctional Institution (KMCI). The population without KMCI in 2000 was 1,533.

LABOR FORCE

In 2000, Greenbush had 954 residents in the labor force not including KMCI. In March of 2010, Sheboygan County has a total of 63,379 people in the labor force and an unemployment rate of 10.0%.

UTILITIES

WATER & SEWER

The Town of Greenbush does not have a public water system. Residents within the Town have individual wells.

ELECTRICITY

Provided by We Energies

NATURAL GAS

Provided by Wisconsin Public Service (WPS).

TELECOMMUNICATIONS

Landline phone service is provided by Verizon north and AT&T. Time Warner Cable offers broadband services in portions of the township.

TRANSPORTATION

The Town is located along State Highway 67 and 23. No rail service is available. Sheboygan County Memorial Airport (SMB) is 12 miles away.

HOUSING

Using 2000 Census data, the median housing value in the Village was \$133,500 and is higher than the median housing value of the entire County.

BUSINESS PARKS

Currently there are no business parks in the Town of Greenbush. The City of Plymouth has three industrial parks. The Town of Greenbush plans for small commercial businesses or light industrial development near State Highway 23.

INCOME

Greenbush's median household income in 1999 was \$54,118, which was higher than the State and Federal median household income.
