




## Town of Herman, WI ECONOMIC PROFILE

The Town of Herman is located in northeastern Sheboygan County along the Manitowoc County border. The Town of Herman is a predominately rural, agricultural area surrounding the Village of Howards Grove and the unincorporated areas of Ada and Edwards. The Town places a high value on the preservation of farmland as a key economic element in the Town. The Town is a mix of carefully sited new single-family residences, small businesses, and small home-based businesses. The Town is home to Lakeland College.

## UTILITIES

### WATER & SEWER

The Town of Herman does not have a public water system or a public sewer system. Residents within the Town have individual wells and on-site sanitary systems that are owned and maintained by individual property owners. The exception to this community-wide standard is Lakeland College, who has a private wastewater treatment facility located on their campus.

### TELECOMMUNICATIONS

Landline phone service is provided by TDS Telecom. Broadband internet is offered by Time Warner in parts of the town.

## TRANSPORTATION

The Town is intersected by State Highway 32 and 42. Rail service is not available. Sheboygan County Memorial Airport (SMB) is 11 miles away.

## HOUSING

Using 2000 Census data, the median housing value in the Village was \$108,600 and is lower than the median housing value of the entire County.

## BUSINESS PARKS

Currently there are no Business Parks in the Town of Herman. As the Town of Herman does not have public sewer or water and is predominately an agricultural community, large business and industrial growth is better suited for other areas, such as Howards Grove or the Town of Sheboygan.
